The 2010 BoardSource Nonprofit Governance survey reported that 2/3 of boards received a C, D, or F rating on board performance from their chief executive. Is your board performing? Do your board members support your fundraising efforts? Are they actively participating on your committees? Are your board members too polite to ask the hard questions? Does it seem like just a few people do all the work?

If your board is underperforming it will hinder the success of your organization. Take advantage of this three-hour interactive workshop where we will explore strategies and techniques that you can use to improve your board's culture and performance.

We will discuss strategies for creating clear expectations for board members and review the role of the Board and the Executive Director in board development. We will also discuss board culture, board recruitment, committees, board education, and board self-assessments.
